Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 7 will sit their assessment test on Thursday 16th March 2017.

There are plenty of revision materials that pupils can access, in particular the maths watch website on which I have created a revision assignment for all pupils. When pupils access their own account (details below) they will be able to open the revision document. There are a number of questions attached to each topic and if your son/daughter is struggling with a particular topic they can also watch the video that accompanies the question at the bottom of the screen. Some pupils have said that this is not the way they revise; however completing questions is the only way to check that pupils have a sound understanding of the topics. I wanted to ensure that pupils had access to as many questions as possible and I am aware that there are a very large number of questions. Pupils can complete as many questions as they feel necessary until they are confident with a particular topic. I advise that pupils do any necessary working out in the back of their exercise book and then enter their answers on the interactive document. The question will turn green if the answer is correct. (I have found that you sometimes have to click submit a few times for this to register). This is instant feedback for the pupils.

The kerboodle website is where you can view the topics covered in chapters 4 to 7. Once logged into the website you need to click on the 'my maths KS3' tab and then on digital book. Pupils in Set 1 and 2 follow the 1C book and pupils in set 3 and 4 follow the 1B book.
